ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, being a natural person(s) competent to contract, hereby, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of the corporation shall be READING RESCUE, INC.

ARTICLE II

NATURE OF BUSINESS: The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

1. Professional development for elementary school personnel in literacy.
2. Consultant for school administrators in literacy education.
3. Evaluation of school literacy programs.
4. To conduct business in, having one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of real property and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks, and licenses in the State of Florida and all other states and countries.
5. To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness and execute such mortgages, or transfers of corporate indebtedness as required.
6. To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation engaged in same or other character of business.
7. To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bond securities, or other evidence of indebtedness created by this or any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock exercise all rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.
8. To engage in any other lawful activity or business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and of the United States of America.

ARTICLE III

CAPITAL STOCK: The maximum number of shares of stock this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is 7,000 shares of common stock at a part value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE IV

INITIAL CAPITAL: The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business is Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

ARTICLE V

TERM OF EXISTENCE: The corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE VI

ADDRESS: The initial address of the principal offices of the corporation is 750 SW 91st St., Gainesville, FL 32607. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in the State of Florida

ARTICLE VII

DIRECTORS: The corporation shall have one (1) director initially and shall be comprised of stockholders only. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by By-Laws adopted by the stockholders but shall never be less than one (1) or more than nine (9). The Directors shall be entitled to one vote for each share of common stock owned.

ARTICLE VIII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The name and address of the sole member of the first Board of Directors to serve for the first year or until otherwise replaced according to the By-Laws adopted by the stockholders is: Nora L. Hoover, 750 SW 91st St., Gainesville, FL 32607.

ARTICLE IX

SUBSCRIBER: The name and address of the subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is Nora L. Hoover, 750 SW 91st St., Gainesville, FL 32607.

ARTICLE X

REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED ADDRESS: Nora L. Hoover, whose address is 750 SW 91st St., Gainesville, FL 32607 is authorized to serve as the initial registered agent of the corporation to accept service of process as registered agent of the corporation.

ARTICLE XI

PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS: Each shareholder of this corporation shall have a pre-emptive right to purchase additional shares of the corporation at any such time as the same are offered for sale by the corporation.

ARTICLE XII

BY-LAWS: The stockholders shall be authorized to adopt by-laws, including therein a provision for replacement of loss or destroyed stock certificates; for a lien upon the stock for stockholders' indebtedness to the corporation; that such by-laws are not to be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida; that the by-laws can be amended by the stockholders of this corporation; and a provision that, by a stockholder's agreement or by-laws, the corporation may restrict the transfer or encumbrance of any and all the stock.

ARTICLE XIII

AMENDMENTS: These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided herein except as modified by Florida Law. Each amendment must be approved by a majority vote of those stockholders entitled to vote thereon, at a meeting for which at least ten days advance notice was given to all stockholders of the language of the proposed amendment, unless all stockholders execute a written waiver of the requirement for advance notice. Notice shall be accomplished by hand delivery to each stockholder or by furnishing a copy of the notice of meeting to the stockholders last known address by use of United States Postal Services.


