Articles of Incorporation of 40 West 27 Street Corp.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

- Name. The name of this corporation is 40 WEST 27 STREET CORP.
 - Duration. The period of its duration is perpetual.
- Purpose. The purpose is to engage in any and all lawful activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida.
- The corporation is authorized to issue Capital Stock. 10,000 shares, all of one class, at \$1.00 par value.

Cumulative voting. In the election of directors of the corporation, the principle of cumulative voting shall apply. - 13. Bylaws. The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the bylaws of this corporation shall be vested in the directors.
- Indemnification. The corporation shall indemnify any officer, director, employee, agent, or shareholder, or any former officer, director, employee, agent, or shareholder, to the full extent permitted by law.
- 15. Informal Action of Shareholders. If all the shareholders severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the secretary of the corporation, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the shareholders.
- 16. Authority to Mortgage or Pledge Assets. The corporation may not authorize any mortgage or pledge of, or creation of a security interest in, any or all of the property and assets of the corporation for the purpose of securing the payment of performance of any obligation of the corporation, without obtaining prior shareholder approval of any and each such transaction by the vote or written consent of the holders of fifty-five percent (55%) of the shares of the corporation entitled to vote thereon and not otherwise.
- 17. Meetings by Conference Telephone. Officers, Directors, and Shareholders may participate in meetings by means of conference telephone.

- 18. Amendment of Articles. This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.
- Pre-emptive and "First Refusal" Rights. Each shareholder of this corporation shall have the first right to purchase shares (and securities convertible into or carrying a right to subscribe for or acquire shares) of any class, kind, or series of stock in this corporation, including shares sold otherwise than for money, that may from time to time be issued (whether or not presently of including shares from the treasury authorized), corporation, in the ratio that the number of shares he holds at the time of issue bears to the total number of shares outstanding, exclusive of treasury shares. This right shall be deemed waived by any shareholder who does not exercise it and pay for the shares pre-empted within forty-five (45) calendar days of receipt of a notice in writing from the corporation, stating the prices, terms, and conditions of the issue of shares, and inviting him to exercise his pre-emptive rights. This right may also be waived by affirmative written waiver submitted by the shareholder to the corporation within forty-five (45) calendar days of receipt of notice from the corporation. The right extends, as a "right of first refusal," for the same price being offered by a purchaser, for any shares offered for sale, to anyone, by any shareholder of the corporation. Provided, however, there is no preemptive right with respect to shares issued as compensation to directors, officers, agents, or employees of the corporation or shares issued satisfy conversion or option rights created to provide compensation to directors, officers, agents, or employees of the corporation.
