ARTICLE 1. - NAME

The name of this corporation is Baranowicz and Calderon, P.A.

ARTICLE 2. - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in the practice of law and in any activity permitted by Chapter 621.08, Florida Statutes 1997, or its successor.

ARTICLE 3. - POWERS

This corporation shall have all of the powers enumerated in the Florida Business Corporation Act, Chapter 607, Florida Statutes 1997, except as the same may be limited by the Professional Service Corporation Act, Chapter 621, Florida Statutes 1997.

ARTICLE 4. - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 1,000 shares of no par value voting common stock.

ARTICLE 5. - SHAREHOLDERS

No person may be a shareholder in the corporation except individuals who are members of The Florida Bar and who are otherwise licensed and legally authorized to engage in the practice of law in the State of Florida.

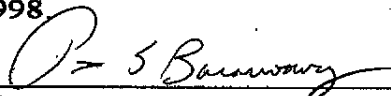
ARTICLE 9. - AMENDMENT

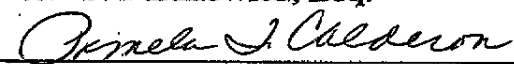

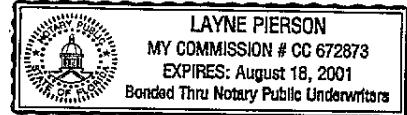
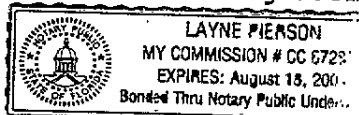
