ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE CLIPPER BEAUTY SALON INC.

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation is an natural person competent to contract and hereby form for non profit Corporation under Section 617.0302 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The Name of the Corporation is **THE CLIPPER BEAUTY SALON INC** . (hereinafter, "Corporation').

ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

The Corporation is organized for the purpose of engaging in any activities or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 3 - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE 7 - CORPORATE CAPITALIZACION

- 7.1 The maximum number of shares that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is one thousend (1,000) shares of common stock, each share having the par value of nighty dollars (\$90.00).

- 7.4 The Board of Director (s) of the Corporation may, by Restated Articles of Incorporation, classify or reclassify any unissued stock from time to time by setting or changing the preferences, conversions or other rights, voting powers, restrictions, limitations as to dividends, qualifications, or term or conditions of redemption of the stock.

ARTICLES 8 - POWERS OF CORPORATION

The Corporation shall have the same powers as an individual to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its business and affairs, subject to any limitations or restrictions imposed by applicable law or these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLES 9 - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLES 10 - REGISTERED OWNERS

The Corporation, to the extent permitted by law, shall be entitled to treat the person in whose name any share or right is registered on the books of the Corporation as the owner thereto, for all purposes, and except as may be agreed in writing by the Corporation, the Corporation shall not be bound to recognize any equitable or other claim to, or interest in, such share or right on the part of any other person, whether or not the Corporation shall have notice thereof.
