The undersigned incorporators of these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

Unless otherwise expressly prohibited by Florida law the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall have the sole and exclusive discretion, on such terms and conditions as it shall determine, to indemnify, or advance expenses to, any such person. No person falling within the purview of this paragraph may apply for indemnification or advancement of expenses to any court of competent jurisdiction.

#### ARTICLE XI

**PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS:** The corporation provides each of its shareholders with all preemptive rights provided by Florida law.


#### ARTICLE XII
