## ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION

The name of the corporation is Kent Burkhart's Office, Inc.

2.

On February 15, 1999, dissolution of the corporation was approved by the Shareholders. The number of shareholders voting for dissolution and the number of shares voted for dissolution was sufficient for approval.

3.

The corporation has caused notice of the Notice of Intent to Dissolve to be published in accordance with O.C.G.A. Sections 14-2-1403.1 (Georgia Code Annotated Section 22-1403.1) and 14-2-1407(b) (Georgia Code Annotated Section 22-1407) of the Georgia Business Corporation Code. Said Notice included a request that persons with claims against the corporation present them in accordance with O.C.G.A. Section 14-2-1407(b) (Georgia Code Annotated Section 22-1407) of the Georgia Business Corporation Code. Said request described the information that must be included in a claim and provided a mailing address where the claim may be sent and stated that except for claims that are contingent at the time of the filing of the Notice of Intent to Dissolve or that arise after the filing of the Notice of Intent to Dissolve, a claim against the corporation not otherwise barred will be barred unless a proceeding to enforce the claim is commenced within two years after the publication of the Notice.

4.

All known debts, liabilities, and obligations of the corporation have been paid and discharged.

5.

All the remaining property and assets of the corporation have been distributed among its shareholders in accordance with their respective rights and interests .

6.

There are no actions pending against the corporation in any court.
