PREAMBLE

We the undersigned Subscribers, natural persons, competent to contract, do hereby associate ourselves under the following Articles of Incorporation, and form a Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of the Corporation shall be A American Auto Transport, Inc..

**ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL ADDRESS AND MAILING ADDRESS**

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSES**

ARTICLE IX
REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

The Registered Agent for this Corporation shall be Richard I. White and the Registered Office shall be located at 840 SW 55th Terrace, Margate, Florida 33068 or such other person or place as the Board of Directors shall from time to time direct, with appropriate notice being given to the Secretary of State in accordance with the law.

ARTICLE X
SPECIAL PROVISIO

Any action by the Board of Directors of this Corporation which is within their powers taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors shall be valid for all intents and purposes whether or not lawful notice of said meeting shall have been given to all Directors as required by law or by the By-Laws of this Corporation, if at any time prior to ,during or subsequent to such meetings all Directors shall execute a Waiver of Notice of such meeting in writing, and providing a majority of the Directors shall have approved or approve the action taken at such meeting.

When not prohibited by law, any action of the Shareholders of this Corporation may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by all the persons who would be entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the Secretary of the Corporation as part of the corporate records. Such consent

shall have the same force and effect as the unanimous vote of the Shareholders and may be stated as such in any certificate or document filed with the Department of State of the State of Florida, or any other governmental agency of any state, county or nation or with any private organization, Corporation, person or persons.

Nothing in this article shall be construed to allow any act of the Board of Directors to be approved by less than a majority of said Shareholders or whatever a greater vote is required by law or in the By-Laws by that vote.

ARTICLE XI

TELEPHONE MEETINGS SUMMARIZED

Members of the Board of Directors or any executive committee designated by the Board of Directors in accordance with the law shall be deemed present at any meeting of the Board of Directors or executive committee. As the case may be, if a conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear and be heard by all other persons is used.

ARTICLE XII

INSPECTION OF BOOKS AND RECORDS

The Corporation shall from time to time determine whether and to what extent and at what time and place and under what conditions and regulations the accounts and books of the Corporation (other than the stock book) or any of them shall be open to inspection of Shareholders and no Shareholders shall have any right of inspecting any account, book or document of this Corporation except as conferred by statutes, unless authorized by a resolution of the Shareholders or by the Board of Directors.

AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner and with the vote provided by law.

ARTICLE XIV
PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every Shareholder upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this Corporation, shall have the right to purchase his pro-rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

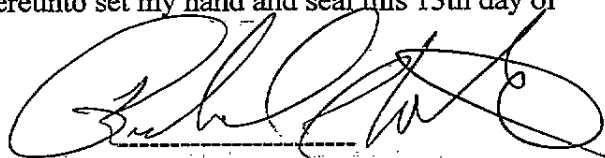
ARTICLE XV

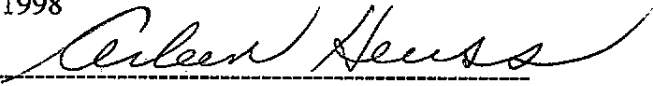

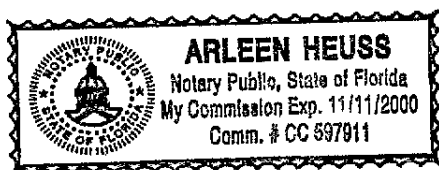

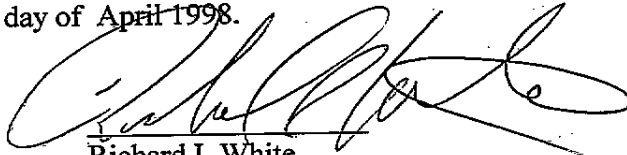
