**ARTICLES OF DISSOLUTION  
OF  
A NEIGHBORHOOD NURSING SERVICE, INC.**

**THE UNDERSIGNED**, as Vice President of **A NEIGHBORHOOD NURSING SERVICE, INC.**, a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), in accordance with Section 607.1403, Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following Articles of Dissolution for the Corporation:

1. Name. The name of the Corporation is "A Neighborhood Nursing Service, Inc".
2. Date of Incorporation. The Articles of Incorporation for the Corporation were filed on May 5, 1998, and assigned document number P98000040404.
3. Authorization to Dissolve. Dissolution of the Corporation was authorized by written consent of the Corporation's shareholders on March 7, 2005, to be effective upon the date of filing with the Florida Department of State. The number of votes cast by the shareholders was sufficient for approval.
