#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WORLD DANCE, SPORTS AND PERFORMING ARTS CONFEDERATION, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation:

#### ARTICLE ONE NAME

The name of the corporation is WORLD DANCE, SPORTS AND PERFORMING ARTS CONFEDERATION, INC.

#### ARTICLE TWO DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

### ARTICLE THREE **PURPOSE**

This corporation is organized for the purposes of operating as a special event coordinator for dance, sports, and performing arts events and education and all other purposes for which a corporation may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act, with a focus on the following objectives:

- 1. To promote and develop the ancient and the modern styles and types of dance of all nations in the world for a better dance world and to understand the dance culture of each nation.
- 2. To preserve, promote, and support all the cultural dance styles of all the nations of the world.
- 3. To organize, promote, and support the world dance museum.
- 4. To organize, promote, support, and preserve the world dance library.
- 5. To organize, promote and develop the worlds finest dance music.
- 6. To organize, promote and support the universal dance congress for the better understanding and preserve each nation's dance culture.

- 7. To promote and support dancing for health reasons for the healthier body, mind and emotions to the citizens of all nations from a happier and healthier world.
- 8. To organize and preserve dance documents and materials from the ancient times to the present, and plan a better future for the world on dance.
- 9. To organize, promote and support the world dance events in all types and styles of dance.
- 10. To promote and develop all types and styles of dancing, such as cultural, theatrical, athletic, acrobatic, dramatic and performing arts. Dance on land, water, or in the air, for the past, present and future of the world and the universe.
- 11. To promote, support, and preserve good dance music for the past, present and future of the world.
- 12. To help the nations for dance cultural exchange for more understanding and better relations between the nations for the world of dance.
- 13. To cooperate with municipalities and communities for the promotion of social and athletic dance.
- 14. To give scholarships and awards for achievement, to the best new dance talents and performing artists of the world.
- 15. To organize, promote, and support world dance events, movies, and musicals with the participation by dancers, musicians and performers from all over the world.
- 16. To organize television broadcasts of dance contests and competitions for the promotion and development of dancing, music, sports and the performing arts.
- 17. To promote and develop the social and athletic dance in Florida, America and abroad through the mass communications media, cinema, videocassettes, live events and festivals.
- 18. To issue a newspaper and other printed material relative to the activities of the World Dance, Sports and Performing Arts Confederation, Inc.
- 19. To offer memberships for the promotion and encouragement of diversified participation and the exchange of information relating to dance, sports, music and the performing arts.
- 20. To organize, promote and support world or universal dance events in all types and styles with dancers from all over the world.
- 21. To promote and develop world or universal dance sport games and world dance games.
- 22. To promote and develop dance as an Olympic sport.
- 23. To promote and support the dance Olympiad in all types and styles of dancing.

- 24. To promote and develop the Ancient Olympian Sports and culture.
- 25. To promote and support the Ancient Olympian Games.
- 26. To organize events for the qualification of athletes, for representation of their nations in the Ancient Olympian Games.
- 27. To find a system to copyright dance choreography for the benefit and recognition of the world choreographers.
- 28. To promote and develop all types and styles of dancing, such as Tap, Jazz, Ballet, Latin, Ballroom, Theatre Arts, Acrobatic, Cultural dancing, Dance Drama and future dancing of the world.
- 29. To promote, establish, and support a dancer's bank of the world for the support of all the dancers of the world and the world dance events.
- 30. To give recognition, awards and support to the world's best dancers, choreographers, dance directors, and dance producers for the achievement and quality of the work accomplishment the contributed to the world.
- 31. To work fully with the United Nation's programs to support dance cultures and dance culture exchange for a better and happier world and better understanding among the nations.
- 32. To award governments, nations, corporations, individuals, for their achievements to promote and support dancing for a better world.
- 33. To organize, promote and support beauty pageants for dances. For solo, men and women, and couples, with the titles: "Most Beautiful dancer of the World", including men and women, and the "Most Beautiful Dance Couple of the world", for each nation, continental, world and universal titles, to combine dance style, beauty and education.
- 34. To organize representatives and for each nation and continents for each style and category of art sports, performing arts, and dance to represent World Dance, Sports and Performing Arts Confederation in the nation, continent or the world. Representatives can be a federation, dance council, association, corporation, or individuals, which accomplished worthwhile achievements for the benefit of dancing in the world.
- 35. To organize an educational system of programs for dance, sports, modeling and the performing arts, at the elementary, high school, college and university levels. To assist graduates of this educational system with job placement.
- 36. To develop a special system that will help members find employment across the globe.
- 37. To perform any other relative activity that shall contribute to the development of art sports, performing arts, and dance, and the accomplishment of any of the above.

World Dance, Sports and Performing Arts Confederation is established for the purpose of improvement, communication, development in harmony, and for better understanding and help for a better dance world, and will not involve or interfere with politics in each nation, or dance organizations' internal affairs. We are only concerned with the program of this constitution for a better dance world and to create enjoyment and education for the dancers, musicians and performers of the world.

## ARTICLE FOUR CAPITAL STOCK

The aggregate number of shares that the corporation has authority to issue is 1000 shares of no par value common stock.

## ARTICLE FIVE PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS GRANTED

Each shareholder of any class of stock of this corporation shall be entitled to full preemptive rights to purchase any unissued or treasury shares of the corporation and any securities of the corporation convertible into or carrying a right to subscribe to or acquire any unissued or treasury shares.

## ARTICLE SIX STOCK TRANSFER RESTRICTIONS

No transfer of stock shall be valid, until ten days after the corporation, through its secretary, shall have had written notice of the proposed sale, the number of shares proposed to be sold, the price at which the proposed sale is to be made, and the name of the prospective buyer. During such ten days, the corporation shall have the option to buy at the price set by seller any shares of outstanding stock, before its owner or the person in whose name it stands on the books of the corporation, may transfer them. Should the corporation not have the funds to buy the shares, or should it deem it undesirable to purchase them for any other reason, another existing shareholder shall have the option, for an additional ten days, of purchasing the shares at the price set by the

seller in proportion to the number of shares then held by the shareholder. In the event a dispute exists between the shareholders and the corporation in regards to the fair market value of the shares, the fair market value will be determined by binding arbitration. In no event may the shares be sold to a third party without the written consent of the Board of Directors. However, the Board of Directors may not unreasonably refuse to allow the sale of shares to a third party.

#### ARTICLE SEVEN TRANSFER EXCEPTIONS

Not withstanding anything herein to the contrary, any shareholder may at any time during such shareholder's lifetime transfer any of such shareholder's share in the company to his or her spouse, father or mother, children (unless those children have not reached their age of majority, in which event the shareholder may transfer the stock in trust for the benefit of such minor children) or to the trustee or trustees under any trust created during his or her lifetime for the benefit of the shareholder, his or her spouse, father or mother, or children. However, the spouse, father, mother, children or trustee shall agree in writing prior to such transfer to become a party to and be bound by all the terms and conditions of the agreement which provides for the corporation's option to purchase shares before sale to other stockholders or third persons, just as if they were original parties to such agreement.

#### ARTICLE EIGHT REGISTERED OFFICE

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1961 Pinehurst Road, Dunedin, FL 34698 and, the name of the initial registered agent is Socrates Charos, whose address is 1961 Pinehurst Road, Dunedin, FL 34698.

#### ARTICLE NINE Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed is as follows:

- 1. The Corporation will provide such Bylaws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes, as they may deem necessary.
- 2. Upon proper notice, the Bylaws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of those members of the Board of Directors present at its regular meeting or special meeting called for that purpose. Providing that notification of the meeting also includes the notice of the proposed amendment to the Bylaws, and provided that a quorum is present.

#### ARTICLE TWELVE **Amendment of Articles of Incorporation**

1. The Corporation may amend these Articles of Incorporation for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes, as they may deem necessary from time to time.

2. Upon proper notice, the Articles may be amended by a majority of those members of the Board of Directors present at the regular meeting or special meeting called for that purpose, providing that the notification of the meeting also includes the notice of the proposed amendment to the Articles and provided that a quorum is present.
