OF

The undersigned subscriber to these articles of incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby applies to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

SECTION 1.01 NAME: The name of this corporation is:

SECTION 2.01 CAPITAL STOCK. The maximum number of shares of par value common of non par common and preferred stock and of every kind, class or series of each, with their distinguishing characteristics and the par value of all shares having par value that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is:

100 shares of \$5.00 par value

SECTION 3.01 INITIAL CAPITAL. The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business is \$500.00.

SECTION 4.01 TERM OF EXISTENCE. This corporation is to exist perpetually.

**SECTION 9.00 NATURE OF BUSINESS.**

**SECTION 9.01.** To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of any and all activities permitted under the law of the United States and of the State of Florida.

**SECTION 9.02.** To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services of every class, kind and description except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, cemetery company, a building and loan association, mutual fire insurance association cooperative association, fraternal benefit society, state fair or exposition.

**SECTION 9.03.** To conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of real and personal property including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks and licenses in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries.

To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property or other instrument to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold sell, transfer mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

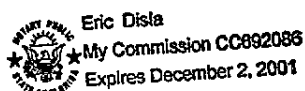

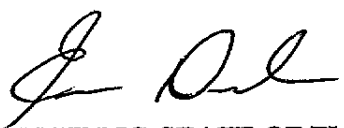
