ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, acting as an Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida BLAINE SEE. FLORIDA Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is: Sailing Adventures, Inc.

ARTICLE II - Principal Office and Mailing Address
