1. The initial bylaws of this corporation shall be adopted by the board of directors. The bylaws may be amended from time to time by either the stockholders or the directors. The stockholders may amend, alter or repeal any bylaw adopted by the directors. 2. Each director and officer of the corporation, whether or not then in office, shall be indemnified by the corporation against all cost and expenses reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with or arising out of any claim, demand, action, suit or proceeding in which he may be involved or to which he may be made a party by reason of his being or having been a director to include attorneys' fees and cost of reasonable settlement made with a

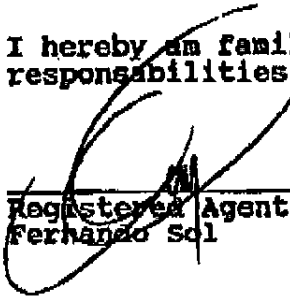
view to curtailment of costs of litigation, except in relation to matters as to which he finally shall be adjudged in any such action, suit, or proceeding to have been derelict in the performance of his duty as such officer or director. Such right of indemnification shall not be exclusive of any other rights to which he may be entitled as a matter of law, and the foregoing right of indemnification shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, executors and administrators of any such directors or officers.

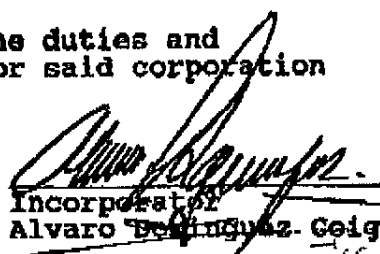
4. A director or officer of the corporation shall not be disqualified by his office from dealing or contracting with the corporation either as a vendor, purchaser, or otherwise, nor shall any transaction or contract of the corporation be void or voidable by reason of the fact that any director or officer or any firm of which any director or officer is a member or any corporation of which any director or officer is a stockholder, officer, or director, is in any way interested in such transaction or contract, provided that such transaction or contract is or shall be authorized, ratified, or approved by either: (a) a vote of majority of the board of directors having no interest in such contract or transaction; or (b) the written consent or vote of a majority of the outstanding shares of stock in the corporation entitled to vote. A director interested in the contract or transaction who is present may participate in the meeting and may be counted for quorum purposes.

Additional, no director or officer shall be liable to account to the corporation for any profits realized by, from, or through any such transaction or contract authorized, ratified, or approved as herein provided by reason of the fact that he, or any firm of which he is a member or any corporation which he is a stockholder, was interested in such transaction or contract. Nothing herein contained shall create liability in the events above described or prevent the authorized approval of such contract in any other manner permitted by law.
