Dear Sirs:

I am writing to you in an effort to reinstate my S-Corporation, which was dissolved in 1999 unbeknownst to me.

I initiated the company in 1998 and moved to New Mexico in 1999 to go to graduate school. I did not begin to see revenue in the company until later in 2001. When I was working with my CPA in Miami to file the returns, they informed me that the S-Corp had been dissolved because I had not filed the appropriate forms.

I did not intend to dissolve the company and I surely would have filed the necessary forms and paid the \$150 annual fee had I known about them. When I moved to New Mexico, I forwarded my new address to the Florida Department of State, however I received no correspondence from them. I assumed that when I started making money through the S-Corp I would then have to file returns.


Thus, I am enclosing a check for \$600 to cover the 4 years of filing fees that I have not paid. This is intended to cover 1999, 2000, 2001, and 2002. I ask that the penalty be waived because it is excessive, especially for a small company like mine and because I would have readily paid had I known about the fees.

I am enclosing my application for reinstatement, as well as a printout of the webpage on sunbiz.org that details the information about my company.
