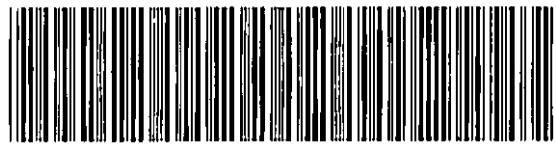

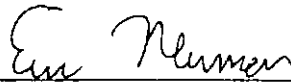
1. The name of the Corporation is MANLO, INC.
