ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

DILLION TIMBER, INC.



I, the undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, being a natural person competent to contract, do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge, and file these Articles for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be DILLION TIMBER, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the date of filing of the Articles of Incorporation in the Office of the Secretary of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business, both within and without the State of Florida. Additionally, the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be:

- (a) To harvest timber from real property and sell the property in parcels.
- (b) To own real and personal property, and to use, operate, maintain, remodel, improve, and generally deal with and in the same, and any appurtenances convenient, desirable, or necessary in the conduct and operation of the lawful business of the corporation.
- (c) To do all and everything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of the objects and purposes of the corporation, as determined by the Corporation's Board of Directors in its discretion and

consistent with the laws of the State of Florida, or as necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the corporation, and in general to carry out any lawful business, regardless of whether such business is similar in nature to the objects as set forth herein, and in any part of the world, either as principal, agent, contractor, or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with any other persons, firm, associations, corporation, or other entities, both within and without the State of Florida, to the same extent as natural persons lawfully might or could do, insofar as acts may be

ARTICLE IV

permitted to be done by a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

This corporation is authorized to issue One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock, each share of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00). No shares without nominal or par value shall be issued.

ARTICLE V

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation, shall have the right to purchase a pro rata share thereof, as nearly as may be done with issuance of fractional shares, at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE VI

The street address of the principal office of this corporation is 1420 Highway 297A, Cantonment, Florida 32533. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation is Daniel C. Griffith, whose address is 1420 Highway 297A, Cantonment, FL 32533.

ARTICLE VII

This corporation shall have three (2) directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time as provided in the Bylaws of the corporation, but the number of directors of the corporation shall not be less than one nor more than nine. The names and addresses of the initial directors of this corporation are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended upon receiving the affirmative vote of the holders of two-thirds of the shares then outstanding at any regular or special meeting of the stockholders upon advance notice given of the changes to be made in accordance with the Bylaws of the corporation. Upon approval by the Secretary of State, any such amendment shall become and be taken as part of the original Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IX

The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal the Bylaws of the corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE X

At each election for directors, every shareholder entitled to vote at such election shall have the right to accumulate his vote by giving one candidate as many votes as the number of directors to be elected at that time, multiplied by the number of his shares, or by distributing such votes on the same principle among any number of such candidates.

ARTICLE XI

Special meetings of the shareholders may be called by the president and secretary of the corporation, jointly, or by the Board of Directors, or by the holders of not less than thirty percent (30%) of the shares then outstanding.

ARTICLE XII

At any meeting of the stockholders, sixty percent (60%) of the shares entitled to vote, represented in person or by proxy, shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is present, the affirmative vote of a majority of the shares represented at the meeting entitled to vote on the subject matters shall be the act of the shareholders.

ARTICLE XIII

This corporation shall have all of the corporate powers enumerated in the Florida General Corporation Act, Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, as such chapter presently exists or may hereafter be amended.
