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#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### MARJAE, INC.

JOHN S. STERRETT and MARYBETH STERRETT, natural persons competent to contract do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, these Articles of Incorporation, as by law provided.

## ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be MARJAE, INC.

# ARTICLE II GENERAL NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States of America and the State of Florida.

## ARTICLE III CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by this corporation shall be FIVE HUNDRED (500) shares having a par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) per share. Each of said shares of stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one (1) vote at any meeting of the Stockholders. All or any part of said capital stock may be paid for in cash, in property (other than stock or securities), or in labor or services at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Incorporators, or by the Board of Directors, at a meeting called for such purpose. All stock when issued shall be fully paid for and shall be nonassessable.

# ARTICLE IV INITIAL CAPITAL

The amount of capital with which this corporation shall begin business shall be no less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

## ARTICLE V TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

## ARTICLE VI PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The following shall be the street address and the principal office of this corporation, but the corporation shall have the power to move the principal office to any other address in the State of Florida, and to

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establish branch offices and other places of business at any such other places within or without the State of Florida that may be deemed expedient:

#### ARTICLE VII DIRECTORS

There shall be a Board of Directors for this corporation which shall consist of not less than one (1) and not more than nine (9), the number of the same to be fixed by the corporate By-Laws. # ARTICLE X CONFLICT OF INTEREST

No contract or other transaction between this corporation and any other corporation, and no act of this corporation shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the

officers of this corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, or are Directors or Officers of, such other corporation; any Director individually or any firm of which any Director may be a member may be a party to, or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in any contract or transaction of this corporation, provided that the fact that he or such firm so interested shall be disclosed thereof, and any Director of this corporation who is also a Director or Officer of such other corporation or who is so interested may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any such meeting of the Board of Directors, and may vote at any such meeting of the Board of Directors of this corporation which shall authorize any such contract or transaction, with like force and effect as if he were not such a Director or Officer of such other corporation or not so interested.

# ARTICLE XI INDEMNIFICATION
