The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is AJAX CONSOLIDATED SERVICE CORPORATION. The initial principal address and registered office address is: 442 S.W. 12th Avenue, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33442.

ARTICLE TWO

The corporation shall become effective as of the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE THREE

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR

The general purposes for which the organization is organized are:

1. To engage in the lease, purchase, mortgaging and sale of personal or real property.
2. To engage in any other trade or business which can, in the opinion of the Board of Directors of the corporation, be advantageously carried on in connection with or auxiliary to the foregoing business.
3. To do such other things as are incidental to the foregoing or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish the foregoing.

4. To have a corporate seal, which may be altered at any time, and to use the same by causing it or a facsimile thereof, to be impressed, affixed or in any other manner reproduced.

5. To purchase, take, receive, lease or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve or otherwise market and use real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.

6. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.

7. To lend money to and use its credit to assist its officers and employees.

8. To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge or otherwise dispose of and otherwise use and deal in and with, any share or other interest in or obligations of any other domestic or foreign corporation, association, partnership or individual or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district, or municipality or of any other instrumentality thereof.

9. To make contracts and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue notes, stocks, bonds and other obligations and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, assets and income.

10. To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds and take hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.

11. To conduct its business and carry on its operations in accordance with such powers as granted by law within or without this state.

12. To elect or appoint officers and agents of the corporation and define their duties and fix their compensation.

13. To make and alter by-laws, not inconsistent with its Articles of Incorporation or with the laws of this state, for administration and regulation of the affairs of the corporation.

14. To make donations for the public welfare and for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.

15. To transact any lawful business which the Board of Directors deems to be in aid of government policy.

16. To pay pensions and establish pension plans, profit sharing plans, stock bonus plans, stock option plans and other incentive plans for any or all of its directors, officers and employees.

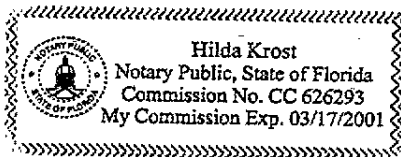
