The undersigned Incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forma a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation shall be:

SOUTHERN STATES TELEPHONE, INC.

Its business shall be carried out at Orange County, Florida, or at such other points or places in the State of Florida, the United States or foreign countries as may, from time to time, be authorized by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by the Corporation is as follows:


