OF

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is EIC, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

The corporation shall commence its existence on the date of filing and acknowledgment of these Articles and its existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE
