ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

Next Generation Communications, Inc.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

Section 1.1. Name.

The name of the corporation is Next Generation Communications, Inc.

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ARTICLE II DURATION

<u>Section 2.1. Duration.</u> This corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles are executed and acknowledged, expect that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five (5) days, exclusive of legal holidays, after they are executed and acknowledged, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

Section 3.1. Purposes. This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV CAPITAL STOCK

- Section 4.1. Number. The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is two-thousand (1,500) shares of Capital Stock with a par value of one (\$1.00) dollar per share.
- Section 4.2. Capital. The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business shall be not less than one thousand (\$1,000) dollars.
- Section 4.3. Class of Stock. The shares of this corporation are all of the same common class.
- Section 4.4. Transfer Restriction. Shareholders must first offer shares to the corporation or other existing shareholders, ratably in accordance with their existing ownership percentages, prior to offering shares to other prospective purchasers.
- <u>Section 4.5. Merger Approval.</u> The approval of a majority of the shareholders of this corporation to any plan of merger or consolidation shall be required in every case.
- Section 4.6. Other. Shareholders shall have no preemptive rights. Cumulative voting shall not be permitted.

ARTICLE V INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

Section 5.1. Office.
