The undersigned hereby makes, subscribes, acknowledges, and files this certificate for the STATE purpose of becoming a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida: FALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be ARAS PUBLISHING, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

- iii. If a majority of the disinterested directors so requests, by a qualified independent arbitrator.

Success on the merits in defense of any action, suit or proceeding shall be determinative that the person acted within the necessary standard of conduct and no further determination shall be necessary. Expenses, including attorneys' fees, incurred in defending a civil or criminal action, suit or proceeding may be paid by the Corporation in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding, upon a preliminary determination by the disinterested Board members that the person did not act with gross negligence or willful misconduct, upon receipt of an undertaking by such person to repay such amount upon any ultimate determination that he acted with gross negligence or willful misconduct.
