

OF

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The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of SECRETARY OF STATE
Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA
forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be DAYTONA CRUISERS, Inc.
The street address of the initial registered office of the
corporation shall be 618 West New York Ave., DeLand, Florida
32720 and the name of the initial registered agent of the
corporation at that address is Richard R. Cook, the mailing
address of the Corporation shall be P.O. Box 1929, DeLand, FL
32721-1929.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage or transact in any or all lawful
activities or business permitted under the laws of the United
States, the State of Florida or any other state, country,
territory, or nation.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation
is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 1,000 shares
of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE V. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE VI. PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder upon the sale for cash of any new stock of
this corporation of the same kind, class, or series as that which

he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE VII. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

It is the intent of the incorporator that this corporation will qualify under the Section 1244 of the Internal Revenue Code and that the corporation will file as a Subchapter S Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII. DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have no directors initially.

ARTICLE IX. OFFICERS


The officers of the corporation shall be elected by the shareholders at the organizational meeting.




