


ARTICLE I CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is Norman N. Brooks, D.D.S., P.A..

ARTICLE II LOCATION

Any director or officer who is involved in litigation or other proceeding by reason of his or her position as a director or officer of this corporation shall be indemnified and held harmless by the corporation to the fullest extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE VIII DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IX AMENDMENT

The corporation reserves the right to alter, ament and repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed in its Bylaws or otherwise at law.
