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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF L'ANTICA CORPORATION

FIRST:

The name of the corporation (hereinafter the

"Corporation") is L'Antica Corporation.

SECOND:

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence.

THIRD:

The address of the initial registered office of the

Corporation in Florida is:
