WHEREAS, the undersigned, being the sole shareholder of the capital stock of THE LITTER BOX, CORP., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, have determined that it would be advisable and in the best interest of the corporation and its sole shareholder for the corporation to be dissolved; now thereof, be it:

- 1. RESOLVED, that the sole shareholder of THE LITTER BOX, CORP. hereby consents to the dissolution of the corporation;
- 2.
