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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

DAVID F. SWEENEY, D.D.S., P.A.

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The undersigned incorporator hereby executes and acknowledges these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation shall be:

DAVID F. SWEENEY, D.D.S., P.A.

ARTICLE II

Business and Purposes

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation, or the objects or purposes of the corporation, shall be as follows:

(a) to engage solely and specifically in the business of carrying on the general practice of dentistry.

(b) to invest in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds or any other type of investments;

(c) to own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of the above professional services;; and

(d) in general, to have and exercise all powers conferred by the laws of Florida upon professional service corporations, and to do any and all things hereinabove set forth to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

ARTICLE III

Capital Stock

(a) The aggregate number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by this corporation shall be 7,500 shares of common stock with a par value of \$1.00 per share. Each share of said stock shall entitle the holder thereof to one vote at every annual or special meeting of the stockholders of this corporation. The consideration for the issuance of said shares of capital stock

may be paid, in whole or in part, in cash, in other property (tangible or intangible) or in labor or services actually performed for this corporation, at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors. When issued, all shares of stock shall be fully paid and nonassessable.

(b) In the election of directors of this corporation, there shall be no cumulative voting of the stock entitled to vote at such election.

ARTICLE IV

Existence of Corporation

This corporation's existence shall begin on August 1, 1998; and, thereafter, this corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V

Principal Office, Registered Office and Registered Agent

The principal office, mailing address and initial registered office of this corporation shall be located at 921 S. Parsons Avenue, Brandon, Florida 33511 and the initial registered agent of this corporation at such office shall be David F. Sweeney. This corporation shall have the right to change such principal and registered offices and such registered agent from time to time, as provided by law.

ARTICLE VI

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall consist of not less than one (1) nor more than seven (7) members, the exact number of directors to be fixed from time to time by the stockholders or the bylaws. The business and affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors, which may exercise all such powers of this corporation and do all such lawful acts and things as are not by law directed or required to be exercised or done only by the stockholders. A quorum for the transaction of business at meetings of the directors shall be a majority of the number of directors determined from time to time to comprise the Board of Directors, and the act of a majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the directors. Subject to the bylaws of this corporation, meetings of the directors may be held within or without the State of Florida. Directors need not be stockholders. The stockholders of this corporation may remove any director from office at any time with or without cause.

ARTICLE VII

Initial Board of Directors

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of one (1) member, such member to hold office until their successor has been duly elected and qualifies. The name and street address of the initial director is:

ARTICLE IX

Bylaws

(a) The power to adopt the bylaws of this corporation to alter, amend or repeal the bylaws, or to adopt new bylaws, shall be vested in the Board of Directors of this corporation; provided, however, that any bylaw or amendment thereto as adopted by the Board of Directors may be altered, amended or repealed by vote of the stockholders entitled to vote thereon, or a new bylaw in lieu thereof may be adopted by vote of the stockholders. No bylaw which has been altered, amended or adopted by such a vote of the stockholders may be altered, amended or repealed by the vote of the directors until two years shall have expired since such action by vote of such stockholders.


(b) The bylaws of this corporation shall be for the government of this corporation and may contain any provisions or requirements for the management or conduct of the affairs and business of this corporation, provided the same are not inconsistent with the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, or contrary to the laws of the State of Florida or of the United States.

ARTICLE X

Amendment of Articles of Incorporation

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon the stockholders herein are subject to this reservation.

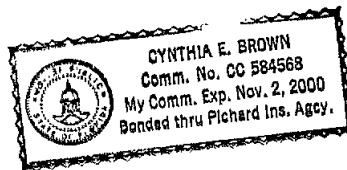


