ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AFFORDABLE PAINT SERVICES, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of this Corporation under the provisions of Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, as amended, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME OF THE CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is AFFORDABLE PAINT SERVICE, INC. hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual unless dissolved according to law.

The Corporation elects to have preemptive rights. Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new or reissued stock of the Corporation, shall have the right to purchase his pro-rata share thereof at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE VII: INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT
