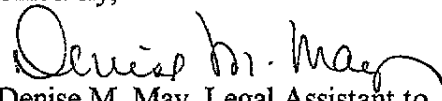

The undersigned, for purposes of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the corporation shall be DEWEY MOCKLER, P.A. The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 1424 Dean Street, Fort Myers, Florida 33901.

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation may engage in each and every aspect of the general practice of law but only through its officers, employees and agents, who are duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render such professional services; and engage in any and every other activity permitted from time to time for a corporation so formed to engage

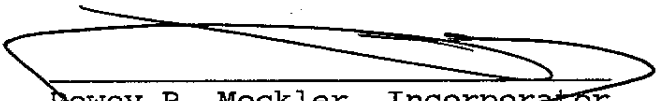
