This is the second letter I am writing in connection with this matter. My first letter was unanswered. For your convenience, enclosed is a copy of my first letter detailing why the original Corporate Annual Report was not filed by its original due date.

In my July 16th letter, I indicated that our company was incorporated in the latter part of 1998 and never received a State of Florida annual report until we received your packet (stamped 2nd notice) for the first time. We immediately completed the Profit Corporation Annual Report and remitted it with a check for \$150. The State of Florida cashed this check (please see copy of front and back of canceled check enclosed) and we assumed that this issue was put to rest.

Now, three months after our July 16th letter, we received another notice that our company is being dissolved. I cannot understand this. We are attempting to comply with the states rules and regulations and nobody seems to take this into consideration. All we get is notices assessing additional penalties. We are a very small business, currently the balance in our checking account as of this date is \$38.08 and you are attempting to impose a penalty of \$750.

The fact that we are a new business, have very little activity, and filed and paid the annual report fee of \$150 as soon as we were informed by the state that we were required to file a Corporate Annual Report should provide the state with sufficient information to abate this penalty. Based upon the above, please reinstate our corporate status and give us credit for the \$150 check that was cashed by the state.
