Dear Department of State, Division of Corporations:

I am writing in regards to my Uniform Business Report, which is enclosed. I recognize this is late. However, it is due to an unfortunate oversight born of extreme circumstance. Earlier today, we spoke with Laura in your department. She said to send this letter of explanation along with the report and a check for \$150.

I originally completed the report and signed and dated it on January 13, 2002, with every intention of writing the check and mailing promptly.

Let me regress by saying here that I am a one-person operation. At the time, not only had I been very ill throughout the fall and winter, but I also became pregnant and even more ill. Though I focused what energy I had on meeting my contractual obligations to my clients, while trying to maintain administrative matters as best I could, it was hardly enough to keep important things from slipping through the cracks. Then, tragedy occurred; my stepfather tried, and almost succeeded, in committing suicide. Being his and my mother's only family, I had to turn my attention to assisting them through great physical and mental challenges. As if this weren't enough, I was in the midst of selling and purchasing a home, meaning that Kimbrough Communications' office, was also being moved (See new address on form enclosed).

To cut to the chase, my Uniform Business Report became lost in a pile of paperwork that was packed and stored until just last night, when I found the box. (Unpacking has been a slow process due to being in my third trimester of pregnancy.) I was devastated to discover that I had missed the May 1 deadline and thus could be penalized \$400, no small amount of money for a tiny company such as mine.

I'm sure you hear many sob stories. And it is with no loss of pride that I write to you asking for exception to the rule. I have always met my obligations to your department, however, and I hope that this tardiness will be forgiven in light of my previous record.

If, however, there are no allowances, please let me know and I will send a check for an additional \$400.
