I received your letter dated December 28, 2000, but not postmarked until January 2, 2001. Your letter indicated that your office was unable to waive the reinstatement fee, unless our corporation never received prior notification from your office.


Our company did not receive prior notification by mail prior to the Notice of Administrative Dissolution or Revocation. Perhaps it was because we had been Administratively Dissolved in 1999; maybe it was for some other reason that the notification didn't reach us. But after having paid the reinstatement and Certificate of Status fees at the end of 1999, I wouldn't have overlooked the document(s) and made the same expensive mistake again.

In my letter to you dated December 26, 2000, I indicated that I had discussed our company's situation with one of your staff members, and now remember that the person I talked with strongly suggested that I include remarks both confirming our conversation and about not having prior notification.

With this in mind, and with your reply not postmarked until January 2, 2001, would you please reconsider our request for Reinstatement and waive the reinstatement fees for 2000 and 2001?
