ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF WESTERN EXHIBIT SERVICES & SUPPLY OF FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is a natural person competent to contract and hereby form a Corporation for profit under Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the Corporation is Western Exhibit Services & Supply of Florida, Inc., (hereafter, "Corporation").

ARTICLE 7: CORPORATE CAPITALIZATION

- 7.1 The maximum number of shares that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is **TEN THOUSAND (10,000)** shares of common stock, each share having the par value of **ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00)**.
- 7.2 No holder of shares of stock of any class shall have any preemptive right to subscribe to or purchase any additional shares of any class, or any bonds or convertible securities of any nature; provided, however, that the Board of Director(s) may, in authorizing the issuance of shares of stock of any class, confer any preemptive right that the Board of Director(s) may deem advisable in connection with such issuance.

- 7.4 The Board of Director(s) of the Corporation may, by Restated Articles of Incorporation, classify or reclassify any unissued stock from time to time by setting or changing the preferences, conversions or other rights, voting powers, restrictions, limitations as to dividends, qualifications, or term or conditions of redemption of the stock.

ARTICLE 8: SHAREHOLDERS'S RESTRICTIVE AGREEMENT

All of the shares of stock of this Corporation may be subject to a Shareholders's Restrictive Agreement containing numerous restrictions on the rights of shareholders of the Corporation and transferability of the shares of stock of the Corporation.
