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# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### Breakwater Real Estate, Inc.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

# **ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation is Breakwater Real Estate, Inc.

# ... ARTICLE II

The duration of the corporation is perpetual.

# **ARTICLE III**

The corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

The corporation shall commence business on filing with the Secretary of State.

# ARTICLE V

The principal place for the transaction of its business and corporate mailing address shall be 1750 J & C Blvd. Unit 5, Naples, FL. 34109. That said corporation shall have the authority to do business at such other place or places within or without the State of Florida, as the corporation may designate by resolution.

#### <u>ARTICLE VI</u>

The amount of capital stock of this corporation shall be ONE THOUSAND SHARES (1000) at One Dollar (\$1.00) par value stock, which stock shall be non-assessable, to be held, sold and paid for at such time and in such manner as the Board of Directors may, from time to time, determine.
