

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF DAVID A. WILLENS AND ASSOCIATES, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber, who is a natural person competent to contract, for the purpose of forming a professional corporation under the Florida Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation and forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation is: David A. Willens and Associates, P.A.

ARTICLE II Nature of Business and Powers

The corporation is being organized to engage in the practice of law and all other lawful business and services of a lawyer. The corporation shall have the power to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its business and affairs.

ARTICLE III Principal Office and Mailing Address
