ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION ON-LINE PROGRESSIVE MARKETING, INC.

The undersigned subscriber(s) to these Articles of
Incorporation a natural person(s) competent to contract under

corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I
