ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

· FOR

ENDERFIELD and Bass Enterprises

We the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, by and under the provisions of the statutes of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liability, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation for profit.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be: Enderfield and Bass Enterprises, Fn(. hereinafter referred to as the corporation.

ARTICLE TWO

The general nature of the business and the objects and purposes proposed to be transacted and carried on, are to do any and all things herein mentioned, as fully and to the same extent as natural might or could do, viz:

- (a) To purchase any and all types of buildings that may be in disrepair, repair same for sale or keep as rental properties.
- (b) To purchase and manage apartment complexe, duplexes, townhouses condominiums and shopping centers.
- (c) To construct various types of buildings for commercialuse, houses for private persons and develope lands for various housing projects.
- (d) To design and manufacture items of furniture and fixtures required and needed to furnish apartments, homes and shopping centers.
- (e) To buy, sell, trade, manufacture, deal in and trade with wares, goods and merchandise of every kind and nature and to carry on such businesses as wholesalers, retailers, importers and exporters.

to acquire all such merchandise, supplies, materials and other articles as shall be necessary or incidential to such businesses; to hold acquire, mortgage, lease and convey real and personal property in conducting the business of the corporation, and to have any and all powers above set forth as fully as natural persons, whether as principals, agents or otherwise.

- (f) To carry on the business of a holding company and to purchase and acquire any merchantile or commercial business, trade or enterprise permitted by the laws of the State of Florida and to own, hold, operate, maintain, use, sell or otherwise dispose of the same. To enter into or engage in any business, trade or enterprise that will profit the corporation.
- (g)To borrow money and contract debts when necessary for the transaction of its business or for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges or franchises or any other lawful purposes of its incorporation. To issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures and other obligations and evidence of indebtedness and to secure the same by mortgage or mortges, deed or deeds of trust, pledge or lien upon any or all of the property, rights, prilileges, or franchises of the corporation wheresoever situated, acquired or to be acquired, to sell, pledge, or otherwise dispose of any and all debentures or other bonds, notes or obligations in such manner and upon such terms as the Board of Directors may deem judicious.
- (h) To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise and to hold for investment, to own, hold, sell, vote and handle shares of stock in other corporations.
- (i) To engage in any commercial, industrial and agricultural enterprises calculated or designed to be profitable to this corporation

and in conformity with the Laws of the State of Florida. To hold, acquire, mortgage, lease and convey real and personal property in any part of the world, so far as necessary or expedient in conducting the business of the corporation and to have any and all powers above set forth as fully as natural persons whether as principals, agents, trustee or otherwise.

- (j) To have one or more offices, conduct its business and promote its objects within and without the State of Florida, in other states, the District of Columbia, the territores and dependencies of the United States and in foreign countries without restrictions as to place or amount.
- (k) To do all and everything necessary, suitable and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the powers herein set forth. either alone or in association with other corporations, firms or individuals and to do every other act or acts thing or things incidential or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects or purposes or any part or parts thereof, provided the same is consistent with the laws under which this corporation is organized.

The total number of shares of capital stock which may be issued by the corporation is Five Million (5,000,000) shares at one cent (.01) par value all of which shall be payablein cash, property, labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for that purpose.
