ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ALLERGY, DERMATOLOGY & SKIN CANCER CENTER, INC.

The undersigned, being a natural person of the age of more than twenty-one years, does hereby act as incorporator in adopting the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of organizing a business corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act.

The name of the corporation ("Corporation") shall be Allergy, FIRST: Dermatology & Skin Cancer Center, Inc.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 8483 South Federal Highway, Suite 19, Port St. Lucie, St. Lucie County, Florida 34952.

SECOND: The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized, which shall THIRD: continue to be the purposes of the Corporation until and if the same be amended pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act, and which shall include the authority of the Corporation to transact any lawful business for which a corporation may be incorporated under the Florida Business Corporation Act, are as follows:

To have all of the powers conferred upon corporations organized under Α. the Florida Business Corporation Act.
