ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, acting as the incorporator of the Corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME OF THE CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation shall be **YOUNG'S VENDING, INC.**

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

AUTHORIZED SHARES

Number: *The aggregate number of shares that the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is 1,000 shares of Capital Stock.*

Initial issue: *100 shares of the Capital Stock of the Corporation shall be issued for adequate consideration in the following manner:*

CAROL N. YOUNG

**One Hundred (100) Shares as
Tenants by the Entireties**

and

MARK W. YOUNG

Dividends: *The holders of the outstanding capital stock shall be entitled to receive, when and as declared by the Board of Directors, dividends payable either in cash, in property, or in shares of the capital stock of the Corporation.*

No Classes of Stock: *The shares of the Corporation are not to be divided into classes.*

ARTICLE V

REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The initial street address in Florida of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 201 Chichester Cove, Longwood, Florida 32779 and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is CAROL N. YOUNG.

ARTICLE VI

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

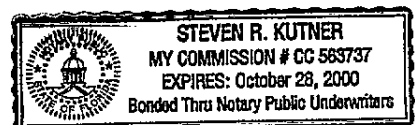
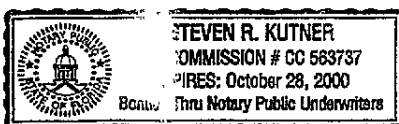
