To whom it may concern,

My name is Sherilyn Lewis. I am the on site bookkeeper and treasurer for Art's Transmission & Tire Service, Inc. (ATTS) Art's Transmission & Tire Service, Inc. is a new corporation formed October 1998. ATTS was transferred from Art's Transmissions, which was a sole proprietorship owned by Arthur Evans, into the newly formed corporation now owned by Arthur Evans and Eric Lewis.

In order to help us be aware of, and up to date on all of our tax liabilities and corporate obligations, we hired The Better Business Bureau's bookkeeping service of Lakeland, Fl. They are (were) suppose to make us aware of any taxes or state fees that corporations are suppose to pay. Well, they dropped the ball on this one.

On, June 29, 1999 we received a packet from the Florida Dept. of State, named 1999 Profit Corporation Annual Report. On the packet in big red letters is a stamp mark that says "2nd Notice". As I continued to read, I noticed that this document was also to serve as our "60 Day Notice" to respond (pay the fee) or our newly formed corporation would be dissolved. This packet also made reference to our corporation number, which is P98000092274. Seeing this number, I began to look through our tax file to try and find something that would be in reference to this number. There I found only one document that referred to that particular number. I believe it is called the articles of incorporation certification verification letter. On this document, in big black bold letters, it states to some degree, that a corporation's annual report must be filed between Jan 1 & May 1 of each year following the year of the filing date noted, and that failure to file may result in the dissolution of said corporation. I continued to read the packet labeled "2nd Notice", and wondered what could happened to the first requested packet. It was not in our tax or accounting files. I personally asked each individual who receives mail at this address if they had seen a packet similar to "2nd Notice", and of course no one had seen the original packet. Obviously, you (Fl. Dept. Of State) have the correct address on file, because we received our certification verification letter as well as "2nd Notice". Unfortunately, we cannot determine what happened to our first packet. We know that it somehow it ended up in the wrong hands, and it had not been paid. If the correct person would have received the packet, we assure you that payment would have been made on time, in order to avoid the \$400.00 late penalty.

As expected, we were shocked and very upset to find that our corporate fee was late. I called our representative at The Better Business Bureau bookkeeping department and asked, "Are all corporations required to pay this fee?" She told me that all corporations are to pay this fee yearly. I then asked her why didn't she inform us that this fee would be due by May 1 or penalties would accue, and even worse our corporation could be dissolved. She said that since we had not sent the packet to her, that she assumed that we had already taken care of that matter. I told her that no one in the office
