Dear Sir or Madam;

I'm writing this letter in the hope that you will accept the standard \$150.00 filing fee instead of charging me the \$550.00 late fee.

We only have the most recent notification in our possession. Neither the Treasurer nor I can recollect receiving the original notice. One possibility that occurs to us is a small mishap that happened in our office around the spring of 2001. A severe downpour came through, accompanied by unexpectedly high winds, which tore back part of the roof over our office. Unknown to us, it must have rained heavily for several hours before the damage was discovered. With our primary focus on getting that section of the roof back over our heads, it was probably even longer!

As you can imagine, we were very distressed to find a considerable number of damaged files, trade reference books, samples, and photos. The majority of loose papers that had been sitting on the desk directly under that gaping hole were soaked beyond recognition. What we could salvage was mostly stuck together, mushy, or runny. Sadly, much of it had to be thrown out.

Although we cannot say for sure that the original notification was part of the disaster, it is one explanation as to why we did not receive the notice. We are a small business. This coming year is the first year that I plan on taking a salary. In addition to this business, I am also a volunteer (unpaid) firefighter, and am in school to become a paramedic. \$400 covers my books and lab fees for the upcoming semesters. There is no way that I would have let the May due date go by if I had been aware of it. Money is not something that I have the luxury of being frivolous with at the moment.

I know that the Department of State runs on its rules and regulations, but I'm hoping that there is a little room for special circumstances. I am pleading with you to accept my \$150 payment that is enclosed. The harsh fines of an additional \$400 late filing fee would place undue hardship on my business and my family considering the situation mentioned above. Thank you again for your consideration in this matter.
