ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of

THE UNDESIGNED, acting as the sole incorporator of **MIOA Acquisition Company VII, Inc.** under Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation of **MIOA Acquisition Company VII, Inc.** for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

Name and Address

The name of the corporation shall be **MIOA Acquisition Company VII, Inc.**, and its principal corporate shall be initially located at 1903 S. Congress Avenue, Suite 400, Boynton Beach, Florida 33426.

ARTICLE II

Duration

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved according to law, and shall commence its corporate existence upon the filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE III

General Purposes

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting, conducting, carrying on, operating, and engaging in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida, and the United States.

Shares

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is One Million (1,000,000), consisting of a single class of common stock, One Cent (\$0.01) par value per share.


