ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF DAVID R. JOHNSON, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, David R. Johnson, being a natural person competent to contract, hereby acknowledges and files these ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida in order to form a Corporation for profit under the provisions of Chapter 607, Florida General Corporation Act and Section 621, Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, of the Florida Statutes does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

CORPORATE NAME

The name of this professional service corporation is DAVID R. JOHNSON, P.A. The principal office and mailing address of the corporation is 1931 Empress Court, Naples, Florida 34110.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This professional service corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing upon the filing of these articles with the Florida Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The general nature and purpose of the business to be transacted, promoted and carried on by the corporation are as follows:

a. To engage in every aspect in the practice of General Medicine, and all its fields of specializations, as are engaged in by Medical Doctors.

- b. To engage and render the professional services involved only through its officers, agents and employees who shall be Medical Doctors in good standing and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional service as this corporation.
- c. To invest the funds of the professional service corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other type of investments permitted by law.
- d. To engage in no other business other than the rendition of the professional services specified herein.
- e. To do everything necessary and proper in accomplishing the purposes herein set forth and to do anything incidental thereto which is not forbidden under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

CAPITAL STOCK

- a. The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 1000 shares of common stock having par value of \$1.00.
- b. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be payable in lawful money or property, labor and services.
- c. Shares of the corporation's stock and certificates shall be issued to only to Chiropractors in good standing and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional services as this corporation.

ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 1931 Empress

Court, Naples, Florida 34110, and the name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at that address is David R. Johnson. The Directors of this Corporation may from time to time change the registered office or registered agent, or both, by appropriate notice to the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall have not less than one Director, as provided by the By-Laws.

Directors shall hold office for the term provided in the By-Laws or until their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

ARTICLE VII

ARTICLE IX

BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal By-Laws shall be vested in the Board of

Directors and the Shareholders in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE X

SPECIAL PROVISION

The stock of this corporation is intended to qualify under the requirements of Section 1244 of the Internal Revenue Code and the regulations issued thereunder. Such actions as are necessary will be taken by the appropriate officers to accomplish this compliance.

ARTICLE XI

ELECTION OF SUBCHAPTER S

This corporation may elect Subchapter S for taxation purposes upon consent of the Shareholders.

ARTICLE XIII

INFORMAL SHAREHOLDER ACTION

Any action of the Shareholders may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing setting forth the action so taken shall be signed by all the Shareholders entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the Secretary of the Corporation as part of the Corporate records.

ARTICLE XIV

SEVERANCE AND TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT

If any officer, director, shareholder, agent or employee of this corporation becomes legally disqualified to render the professional services for which the corporation is organized, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on his continued rendering of such professional services, he shall forthwith sever all employment with the corporation, and shall not thereafter participate or share, directly or indirectly, in any earnings or profits

realized by the corporation on account of professional services. The corporation shall forthwith, upon such disqualification of any shareholder, purchase such shareholder's shares and pay him all amounts owing and lawfully due to him by the corporation, except that such shares shall not be entitled to dividends.

ARTICLE XV

INFORMAL DIRECTOR ACTION

If all of the Directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the Corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the Secretary of the Corporation, the action shall be as valid as through it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.

INDEMNIFICATION

ARTICLE XVI

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer of director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XVII

<u>AMENDMENT</u>

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Florida.
