

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BADGER BOBCAT SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is:

BADGER BOBCAT SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually unless sooner dissolved according to law, commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The general nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on are to do any and all things allowed and permitted to be done by corporations under the Statutes of the State of Florida, and to do any and all of the things hereinafter mentioned as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, to-wit:

(a) To make estimates for itself and for others, and to bid upon, enter into, and carry out contracts for the grading and making of roads, walks, paths, railroads; the construction of bridges, buildings, piers, wharves, fortifications, power plants, and developments, transmission lines, tunnels, subways, drainage, and irrigation systems. To do building, structural, construction, erection, surveying, dredging, shoring, wrecking, salvage, and electrical work of every kind in every part of the world. To manufacture or otherwise, produce, buy, sell, and deal in building materials, and all kinds of materials, supplies, and equipment for masons, carpenters, builders, electricians, engineers, and contractors. To acquire, use, employ, sell and deal in all suitable means, apparatus, machinery, contrivances, equipment, and facilities for prosecuting its business.

(b) To build, erect, construct, purchase, hire or otherwise acquire, own, provide, establish, maintain, hold, work, develop, sell, convey, lease, mortgage, exchange, improve and otherwise deal in and dispose of real estate and real property and all other kinds of property of whatsoever nature, whether real, personal or mixed, or any interests or rights therein without limits as to amounts; to buy, sell,

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assign, convey and cancel liens upon personal property and real estate of every kind and nature whatsoever; to act as broker or agent for the purchase, sale, leasing and management of real estate, and the negotiating of loans thereon; to borrow and lend money and to negotiate loans; to draw, endorse, accept, discount and deliver bills of exchange, promissory notes, bonds, debentures and other negotiable instruments of whatsoever nature, and secure the same by mortgage on its property or otherwise; to issue on commission, subscribe for, take, acquire, hold, exchange and deal in shares, stocks, bonds, obligations or securities of any government or authority, individual or corporation.

(c) To carry on the business of a holding company and to purchase and acquire any mercantile or commercial business, trade or enterprise permitted by the Laws of the State of Florida, and to own, hold, operate, maintain, use, sell or otherwise dispose of the same.

(d) To make and carry out contracts for building, erecting, improving and repairing buildings, structures, improvements, warehouses, docks, bridges, bulkheads, sea walls, fills and structures of every kind and nature whatsoever; to build, construct or repair roads, bridges, wharves, sea walls, sidewalks, ditches, drains, bulkheads and in connection therewith to use any appliance or appliances, dredge or equipment of whatsoever nature for the purpose of so doing; to carry on in any and all of its respective branches and the business of general contracting of whatsoever nature; to own and operate boats, boat lines, bridges and dredges; to make, deepen or widen channels or canals; to fill in low ground; to buy, sell, manufacture, trade and deal in machinery, tools, and in steel, iron, plaster, granite, implements, stone, brick, lumber, shell, sand and every kind of building material and supplies whatsoever; to make all manner of river and harbor improvements; to engage in the building of building and repairing of vessels, ships, boats, crafts and to do any and all manner of marine construction work.

(e) To engage in the sales and commission business in the representation of factories, wholesalers and business which require the use and services of a sales and commissions agency, and to do all things necessary in connection with the operation of a sales and commission agency, as well as to engage in other similar and allied businesses incidental to a sales and commission agency, which said agency will operate both within and without the continental limits of the United States of America.

(f) To own, conduct, operate and maintain a store or stores or distribution centers, warehouse, lofts, lots, storages centers or other outlets for the purpose of manufacturing, making, buying, selling and otherwise dealing in building supplies and equipment incidental to the construction business.

(g) Generally, to make and perform contracts of any kind and description, and for the purpose of attaining any other acts and things, and to exercise any and all powers

which a co-partnership or natural person could do and exercise, and which are now, or hereafter may be authorized by law, and generally do and perform any and all things necessary or incidental to the performing or carrying out of the powers herein above specifically delegated or implied.

ARTICLE IV-CAPITAL STOCK

The capital stock of this corporation shall be divided into 1,000 shares of common stock of \$.10 par value. All said stock shall be payable in cash, property, labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for that purpose; property, labor or services may be paid for, with the capital stock, at a just valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE V-PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every stockholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his or her pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without insurance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.


