# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OMAR J. ARCIA, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, an attorney duly licensed to practice law in the State of Florida, hereby presents these Articles of Incorporation for the formation of a corporation under the "Professional Service Corporation Act," F.S. 621.01 et seq. and other laws of the State of Florida as may be applicable.

## ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is: OMAR J. ARCIA, P.A.

## ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is formed for the following purposes:
