ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

Name and Principal Office

Section 1.1. Name. The name of the corporation is THE VEDRO GROUP, INC.

Section 1.2. Principal Office. The street address and mailing address of the principal office of the corporation is 701 Beach Avenue #301, Atlantic Beach, Florida 32233.

Article II

Duration

Section 2.1. Duration. This corporation shall exist perpetually. Corporate existence shall commence on the date these Articles of Incorporation are executed and acknowledged, except that if they are not filed by the Department of State of Florida within five business days, after they are executed and acknowledged, corporate existence shall commence upon filing by the Department of State.

Article III

Purposes

<u>Section 3.1</u>. <u>Purposes</u>. This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

Article IV

Capital Stock

- <u>Section 4.1</u>. Authorized Capital. The maximum number of shares of stock which this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 10,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.
- Section 4.2. Restrictions on Transfer of Stock. The shareholders may, by bylaw provision or by shareholders' agreement recorded in the minute book, impose such restrictions on the sale, transfer or encumbrance of the stock of this corporation as they may see fit.
- Section 4.3. Approval of Shareholders Required for Merger. The approval of a majority of the shareholders of this corporation to any plan or merger or consolidation shall be required in every case, whether or not such approval is required by law.

Article V

Initial Registered Office: Resident Agent

- <u>Section 5.1</u>. <u>Office Address</u>. The street address and the mailing address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 6620 Southpoint Drive South, #300, Jacksonville, Florida 32216-0989.
- Section 5.2. Resident Agent. The name of the initial resident agent of this corporation at the address set forth in Section 5.1 is Mr. Fred H. Steffey.

Article VI

Directors

- <u>Section 6.1</u>. Number. This corporation shall have one director initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by the bylaws, but shall never be less than one.
- <u>Section 6.2</u>. <u>Initial Director</u>. The name and mailing address of the member of the first board of directors of the corporation is:
 - Alfred S. Vedro, 701 Beach Avenue #301, Atlantic Beach, Florida 32233
- <u>Section 6.3</u>. Compensation. The board of directors is hereby specifically authorized to make provision for reasonable compensation to its members for their services as directors, and to fix the basis and conditions upon which such compensation shall be paid. Any director of the corporation may also serve the corporation in any other capacity and receive compensation therefor in any form.
- Section 6.4. Indemnification. The board of directors is hereby specifically authorized to make provision for indemnification of directors, officers, employees and agents to the full extent permitted by law.

Article VII

Bylaws

Section 7.1. Bylaws. The initial bylaws of this corporation shall be adopted by the directors. Bylaws shall be adopted, altered, amended or repealed from time to time by either the shareholders or the board of directors, but the board of directors shall not alter, amend or repeal any bylaw adopted by the shareholders if the shareholders specifically provide that such bylaw is not subject to amendment or repeal by the directors.


