The City Council of the City of Lake City enacted Ordinance # 98-833 effective September 14, 1998, which provides for a uniform numbering system. This new numbering system will greatly increase the ability of POLICE, FIRE, and EMERGENCY MEDICAL personnel to find your house or business when you have an emergency.

YOUR NEW ADDRESS

893 NW MAIN BLVD

All residences, businesses, industries, schools, churches, organizations and public buildings are covered by this new system. You are required by Ordinance # 98-833 to affix your new address numbers permanently on your house or the principal building where they can be seen easily from the road. If your house or building is not clearly visible from the street or road, you are required to erect a sign at your driveway entrance. Place your new number on the sign facing the road so emergency response personnel coming in either direction can easily see the numbers. It is the responsibility of each property owner, or lessee to post and maintain the new number. The address number must be **no less than three (3) inches in height and one and one half (1-½) inches in width and preferably reflective so they can be seen at night.** All industrial and commercial structures located on large lots or areas in which small residential style address numbers would not be visible from the road must display address numbers not less than ten (10) inches in height. All apartment buildings and multi story buildings must display numbers not less than six (6) inches in height. Apartment numbers for individual units within the complex must be displayed on, above or to the side of the doorway of each unit. All numbers must contrast in color with their background and be visible day or night from the street. When possible, the number must be displayed beside or over the main entrances of the building.

Your mail will be delivered to your old address for a period of one (1) year.

Failure to comply could result in a fine of up to \$250.00 for the first offence, and up to \$500.00 for a second offence. A third offence is a second-degree misdemeanor.

It is very important for your own personal safety to have this address properly displayed. Time wasted during an emergency can make the difference between life and death for members of your family or your neighbors.
