ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
DOYLE, HEALEY & WHITE, INC.

I, the undersigned subscriber to the Articles of Incorporation, natural persons, competent to contract, hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be DOYLE, HEALEY & WHITE, INC. Its principal place of business shall be 5511 Chaparral Street, Holiday, Pasco County, Florida.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business as authorized under the law of the State of Florida or any other state, country or territory under which it may qualify to do business; and more particularly, it shall have all the powers set forth in Florida Statutes Chapter 607 and particularly 607.011, and any and all other powers incidental to the conducting of any and all lawful business.

ARTICLE III

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 1000 at \$1.00 par value common stock.

ARTICLE IV

The consideration for the issuance of said shares or any part thereof shall be money current of the United States of America, or property or services of value at least equivalent to the stock

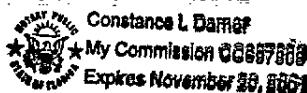

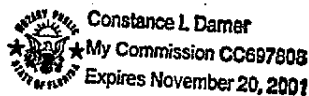
