ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida BIRSTARY OF STATE Corporation Act, Chapter 607 of the Florida Statutes, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is BRIDGEWOOD CORP.

Article 2. Principal Office or Mailing Address. The principal office or mailing address of the Corporation is:
