ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MARC L. LUBET, P.A.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business of this corporation will be to transact any or all lawful businesses for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act. The purpose of the corporation is the practice of law.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The total number of shares of capital stock which may be issued by this corporation is Five Hundred (500) shares without nominal or par value, all of which shall be common stock and shall be fully paid and nonassessable.
