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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR HAUSMAN & BELKIN, P.A.

The undersigned subscriber, Marni B. Belkin, a natural person competent to contract, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I


